OCT	The CBSO Baroque Ensemble come along to play trio sonatas from Italy by Vivaldi, Bassani, Corelli, Locatelli and co.
NOV	Irrepressibly cheerful and bullish music from the young Beethoven played by the Corelli Ensemble.
DEC	Severn's Eight return to explore music by the young Mozart accompanied by members of the Corellis on period instruments.
JAN	David Hatcher (viol) and Warwick Cole (harpsichord) present a programme of music by Bach and his contemporaries.
FEB	The sequel to 2017's Brahms in a Day: a whole day of mini concerts featuring his protégé. Expect a full and varied programme: more details to follow!
MAR	The Enigma Duo of Laurence Kempton (violin) and Katherine Thomas (harp) return to perform an English Songbook with friends.
APR	More passion music of Bach and his contemporaries: the rarely-performed St Luke Passion contains lots of attractive music whether indeed by Bach or not.
MAY	The Oriels return to entertain and illuminate on the subject of the 'Byrd and the Bs' in another delightful choral programme.
